ATMA are pleased to offer a new award for those students who have studied nabim modules 1-7.

The Winner of the GRAEME LUKEY ADVANCED MILLING AWARD by ATMA will receive

Five days of mill training in a state of the art mill in SCOTLAND belonging to CARR'S GROUP. The prize includes flights, 8 night's accommodation, meal allowance, car hire and \$500 for expenses. Total value approximately \$6000.

The award aims to increase the technical skill level of flour milling students from Australia, New Zealand and the Pacific Islands.

Students who are enrolled in nabim modules via ATMA Inc., AND, who complete the module lessons and submit them to the assigned tutor for marking are eligible for this award.

Students must also pass each module on the first attempt.

The aim is to encourage students to put in 100% effort into their nabim studies thereby maximizing their potential. The judging criteria has been largely weighted towards rewarding effort in the completion of the 4 lessons for each module.

The following criteria will be considered by the tutors who will mark a student's efforts accordingly:

- All 4 assignments submitted (5 points)
- Assignments submitted on time (5 points)
- Quality of assignments (7 points)
- Feedback from Tutor (7 points)
- Exam Mark (5 points)
